# How do I apply for the IFS Apprenticeship Programme:

1

Complete the application on [www.ifsapprenticeships.ie](http://www.ifsapprenticeships.ie)

2

All applications are reviewed by the Education Provider to ensure the required candidates have the relevant academic qualifications

3

Candidates with relevant academic qualifications are invited for a pre-screening interview

4

Successful candidates from pre-screening interview are invited to meet with potential hiring companies

5

CVs will be requested by hiring companies

6

Selected candidates are invited for on-site interviews

7

Selected candidates who achieve an IFS Apprenticeship role will commence the academic programme in September 2019

**PLEASE NOTE:** Candidates must be offered an IFS apprenticeship role in a hiring company in order to commence an IFS Apprenticeship programme. The process takes place over a number of months.
